6. Ms Kamo will bring the question and answer session to a close and thank you for talking to the delegates and answering their questions. She will then introduce Steve Maharey, ENZ Board Chair, to speak.

8. There will be a podium on the stage.

9. The audience will comprise 600-700 attendees. Key audience members include education business representatives, chief executives, international marketing directors, international staff, other New Zealand government agencies, NZIEC 2019 sponsors and ENZ staff.

10. NZIEC 2019 is being held on Wednesday 7 and Thursday 8 August 2019.
11. Guy Ryan, Young New Zealander of the Year 2015 and a finalist for Most Inspiring Person in the New Zealand Innovator Awards, will deliver a key note speech entitled “Navigating the needs of future learners”.
12. Dr Lisa Coleman, Chief Diversity Officer at New York University, will deliver a key note speech entitled “Navigating a world of diversity”.
13. Professor Chris Gallivan, Deputy Pro Vice-Chancellor of the College of Humanities and Social Sciences at Massey University, will deliver the closing key note speech entitled “Navigating education transformation”.
