## Purpose

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1. This briefing presents Education New Zealand's (ENZ's) Statement of Intent (SOI) 2022-2026 and Statement of Performance Expectations (SPE) 2022/23 for your information.
2. Under s146(2)(c) and s149(1)(c) of the Crown Entities Act 2004, ENZ must provide you with its final SOI and SPE as soon as possible after receiving any comments.

## Background

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3. As a Crown entity, ENZ's SOI must, for the period to which it relates, set out the strategic objectives that the entity intends to achieve or contribute to, while demonstrating a link between our legislative and statutory objectives.
4. As a Crown entity, ENZ's SPE must set out annual financial and non-financial performance expectations and provide a basis against which financial and non-financial performance can be assessed. An SPE also provides for forecast financial statements for the coming financial year.
5. You received a draft of both documents on 30 April [ENZ 2122-127 refers]. You sent two letters to ENZ's Board on 19 May (CH14458) and 30 May (CH14632). ENZ has considered your feedback when finalising its SOI and SPE.
6. ENZ consulted with the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment when preparing our SOI and SPE. We have sought to incorporate feedback from both agencies on our draft documents when finalising them. They will separately provide you with advice about ENZ's final SOI and SPE.
7. ENZ's Board approved the SOI and SPE on 21 June 2022.

## Overarching comments

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8. Both the narrative and the measures for the SOI and SPE reflect recent policy and fiscal changes to ENZ's operating context, and, in line with your feedback, have been more closely aligned with the draft refresh of the New Zealand International Education Strategy.
9. ENZ anticipates that the refreshed NZIES may lead to changes in its operating environment, and its strategic intent. ENZ considers that the timing of when the NZIES is finalised will determine whether it is practical to amend this SOI, or instead to draft a new SOI.
