PTE and ITP Roadshow in the Philippines 1-10 May 2025

Education New Zealand Manapou ki te Ao (ENZ) 2024/25 Business Plan identifies the Philippines as a 'Grow' market for both the Private Training Establishments (PTE) and Te Pūkenga (Business Divisions (ITP)) sub sectors.

As part of ENZ's efforts to grow the Philippines market, ENZ invites PTEs and ITPs to participate in a roadshow featuring an agent seminar and three student fairs.

The objectives of the events are to:

- Increase awareness of New Zealand education, specifically the PTE and ITP sub sectors and their programmes
- Support inbound student mobility
- Nurture new and strengthen existing agent-institution relationships
- Support the diversification of international students to New Zealand
- Provide in-person platform to showcase ITP and PTE sub sectors

About the roadshow

ENZ will co-host the events with GSIC - Golden Summit International Consultancy, Inc a high performing education agent in the Philippines. GSIC was selected through a RFP process.

The agent seminar is designed to facilitate engagement between representatives from the PTE and ITP sub sector and education agents in the Philippines. The seminar aims to foster mutually beneficial partnerships. The student-focused fairs provide prospective Filipino students and their families the opportunity to meet representatives from the PTE and ITP sub sectors and gather information about studying in New Zealand.

The school roadshow and school counsellors' dinner are designed to provide information sessions about studying in New Zealand to prospective secondary school students and build relationships with school counsellors.

The Filipino programme runs from **1-10 May 2025** covering approximately 3 days each in Manila, Bacolod and Cebu. The programme is all inclusive with sector representatives expected to commit to the full programme.

ENZ's role

ENZ will co-organise the roadshow in collaboration with GSIC - Golden Summit International Consultancy, Inc based in the Philippines.

Selected agent's role

The agent is tasked with the successful execution of the roadshow, including coordinating with participating PTE and ITPs for all event registrations, and logistics before and during the fairs. Additionally, the agent is responsible for promoting, recruiting, and attracting key target audiences to the fairs.

The agent will be required to share all student registration and attendee data for the fairs with ENZ and participating ITP and PTEs.

Budget estimates

- Participating sector representatives are responsible for their own international and domestic flights, on-ground transportations, accommodation, and meals.
- Fee to participate in the roadshow: NZ \$1,000 inclusive of GST per PTE or ITP. There is no provision for selecting specific events the fee covers participation in the entire programme.
- A minimum of 10 providers is required to make the programme viable.
