With so many businesses closed around New Zealand, this is a really difficult time for a lot of people financially. We understand many students will be struggling.

If you are in urgent need of essentials like food, medicine or cleaning products, here are some places that can help:

Your place of study

Under the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016, your place of study has an important responsibility for your health and wellbeing. Contact the international office (or your usual contact) in the first instance to see if they can help you.

Local groups

Community, faith-based and cultural groups are providing support to those in need. To find out what is available in your area, contact Citizen's Advice Bureau: complete the form at cab.org.nz/find-a-cab/contact-us or phone 0800 367 222.

Civil Defence Emergency Management Groups

This service is intended for people who don't have any other options available to them. It operates seven days a week from 7am to 7pm. You can find your local group on the [CDEM website](http://CDEMwebsite). You can also ask to speak with a translator if you need help.

Foodbanks

If you are in urgent need of food or other essentials, you can get a free food parcel from a foodbank in your region on the [New Zealand Foodbanks website](http://NewZealandFoodbankswebsite). We suggest you have your student ID with you when you call.
