### **Purpose**

1. Education New Zealand's (ENZ's) quarterly report for 1 October to 31 December 2022 is attached for your information.

### **Background**

- 2. The quarterly report provides an overview of ENZ's second quarter performance for 2022/23. This quarterly report reflects ENZ's strategic four-year plan and aligns with the New Zealand International Education Strategy 2022-2030 (NZIES).
- 3. ENZ's performance is assessed against ENZ's Statement of Intent 2022-2026, Statement of Performance Expectations 2022/23, ENZ's Business Plan 2022/23 and the Minister's Letter of Expectations. Performance is reported against the following strategic objectives:
